

By now you've setup some an awesome video streaming computer, ditched that cable bill, and you're wondering "how do I quit giving the big phone company \$30/month for my home phone line?". I have the answer. VoIP. Voice Over Internet Protocol. English: phone over internet.

I use magicJack for this. It's just a little dealio I plug into my internet router and a phone line. Ta-da, a phone like for \$ 25 /year. I even still have my same local phone number that I had when I was giving \$30/month to Qwest. Here's the tricks (get it tricks, ha ha) I used.

- 1. Sign up for MagicJack
- 2. Sit and wait by the mailbox for it to arrive.
- 3. Set it up on the magicJack website.
- 4. In your magicJack account, have them get your home line number captured to be used with magicJack.

- 5. Once that number is transferred after a week or two, disconnect the phone line from the outside of the house and use your magicJack to back-feed the phone signal to all the phones in your house through that telephone jack in the basement that you never use.
- 6. Spend all your extra money each month on lavish gifts for your spouse and computer IT people.
